## Use of Cookies

Our Website may use cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This helps us provide you with a good experience when you are browsing our Website and also allows us to improve our Website.

A cookie is a small file which is sent by our server, and which is stored on the hard disk of your computer. It is usually used to identify an individual when that individual is accessing a Website. It keeps a record of the Website visited and contains a certain amount of information regarding the visit.

We may use the following cookies.

§ ***Strictly necessary cookies.*** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our Website. This category of cookies cannot be disabled.

§ ***Analytical/performance cookies.*** They allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

§ ***Functionality cookies.*** These are used to recognize you when you return to our Website. This enables us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

§ ***Targeting cookies.*** These cookies record your visit to our Website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our Website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

collect	google-analytics.com	Used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behavior. Tracks the visitor across devices and marketing channels.	session
NID	doubleclick.net	Registers a unique ID that identifies a returning user's device. The ID is used for targeted ads.	6 months
